

Fauntleroy Community Association Minutes June 11, 2013

The meeting was called to order by President, David Haggerty at 7:05. In attendance were board members; Mike Dey, Vlad Oustimovitch, Bruce Butterfield, Phil Sweetland, and Kathleen Dellplain. Also in attendance were Tracy Record of the West Seattle Blog, and Pierre Davis of the Seattle Police Department.

Vlad reported on the Parks Department Legacy meeting. The meeting was mostly geared to support the upcoming levy. There was discussion of the functions of the Parks Dept., including maintenance and operations.

There has been no response from Seattle Dept. of Transportation to our letter about the Cars2go. There seem to be fewer of them in the neighborhood now.

Gordon Wiehler and Sheila Nishimoto will be monitoring the motorcycle noise with a decibel meter. They intend to identify the unmuffled/unbaffled motorcycles.

Gary Dawson and Mike Dey are drafting responses to our survey. The responses will be ready for review soon, and sent out by September.

Vlad and Pierre Davis from SPD led the discussion of the upcoming safety meeting. One area of concern is the bad lighting in Lincoln Park. They are hoping to recruit more block watch captains at the meeting. Surveillance cameras, both public and private, will be another area of discussion. Predictive policing and a data map with a pattern of calls may also be featured. Pierre stressed that the police want to raise resident awareness and increase community involvement. We will set a date and plan the Safety meeting at our July meeting. September 24th is the tentative date.

The Southwest District Council had a discussion on “apodments”. The land use rules are being skirted, and they are a negative impact in neighborhoods.

The treasury report was sent separately by email. There was not much activity this month.

Bruce reported that Lynn Olson, our former consultant, passed away. A memorial was discussed.

The Parks department has cleaned up the temporary berm at Lincoln Park. The rock used was non-conforming.
