Old Business

SPD update: provided by Jon Flores

- States; YTD car prowls remain up, be diligent
- Residential Burglary; down 35% (top of list of enforcement)
- Motor Vehicle theft up 21%
- Domestic Violence two report this year
- Challenge faced by Department; person sentenced to 6 years, out in 2 with no supervision
- Able to correlate increased activity in specific locations, but due to lack 'probable cause' not able to apprehend anyone. Frustrating for all parties involved

Ferry Task Force:

- Desertion in other location several members have left, looking for replacements
- Gary staying on to continue to having our 'voices heard'
- Next topic for discussion is schedule
- Keeping on with 'test' program at dock, WSDOT is pleased with results increased flow- but getting lots of flack from riders.
- 'test' may conclude in January, yet to be determined

Planter Update:

- Plants are looking great and healthy, especially the higher elevation, 12 volunteers, watering is happening every 2 3 days
- Recent changes at WSDOT, pitch them for Operational Safety Purposes
- 14 new planters requested 6 approved
- Current units are from Canadian manufacturer, expensive -\$300 each, not including soil and plants
- Smaller options are available 36" instead of 50" (currently)
- Alexis to research manufacturer to see if able to develop A and B option
- Look into West Seattle Nursery for discount bulbs and pants

Southwest District Council Update:

- New leadership representative from Junction Association, lots of energy
- Feels like group in on the cusp of resurgence
- Vicki expressed willingness to step down if can find replacement
